Summer Camp Rules & Regulations

1. Parents must sign their child(ren) in and out daily.
2. Staff will not dispense medication to children.
3. All children must be picked up by 2:00 pm daily (except field trip days.)
Three late pickups will result in the child(ren) being dismissed from camp.
Camp fees will not be refunded.
4. Parents will be contacted if the child(ren) become(s) unruly during camp.
5. No profanity or fighting will be tolerated in the camp. Disciplinary action for violation of camp rules lie with the Director or Assistant.
6. Child(ren) should not bring small items, jewelry, or easily lost items to camp.
7. Permission forms must be signed before a child is taken on a field trip.
8. Any repeated and continued misbehavior of a child will be cause and will result in the complete removal of the misbehaved child from Summer Rec. Program.
9. Any behavior which directly threatens the wellbeing or safety of another child(ren) will result in the complete removal of misbehaved child from the Summer Rec. Program. Camp fees will not be refunded.
10. Town of Griswold will not be responsible for the lost of campers personal property. Please keep the expensive gadgets at home.
11. Any form of cancellation of application will result in a charge of \$60 maintenance fee.

- On extra hot days, please pack your child a bathing suit and bring a towel at pick-up.

As you may have noticed, all the field trips except one have been removed from the weekly schedules.

This cut was necessary to keep costs down for our parents. With the increasing prices of tickets/trips/transportation, the cut was implemented to keep our program affordable for you.

In the event of dismissal, it will become my responsibility to arrange for transportation home and assume any financial responsibility for such arrangements. Please review rules on next page.

I give permission for recreation staff to provide basic first-aid for the child named above and take appropriate measures including contacting emergency medical services when efforts to contact me (the guardian) are unsuccessful. Examples are applying band-aids, applying ice and helping everyday minor cuts, scraps, and bumps. I also agree that the director is allowed to contact me in case of incidences, excessive cuts, bumps or burns along with calling 911 if the situation is deemed suitable or if parent/guardian/backup contact is not reachable by phone. It is understood that conscientious effort will be made to notify me before such action is taken. I hereby **relieve** Griswold summer recreation staff, the town of Griswold and its representatives of all responsibility and consequences that might arise as a result of treatment, and injury at camp or on field trips. I agree to accept any financial responsibility as a result of such treatment, ambulance and/or other medical/emergency fees.
